



Register Your Child for Kindergarten

Flossmoor School District 161 has scheduled an additional registration for incoming kindergarten students who will enter the schools this fall.

Kindergarten registration will be offered from **4 to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 25, at Parker Junior High School, 2810 School Street, Flossmoor, IL.**

A full day program (8:40 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.) is available at each elementary school. A District half-day day program will be offered for students who want a half-day program at their home school. This program will be embedded into the full-day program. Students in this program will attend school from 8:40 a.m. – 11:50 a.m. Parents indicate their enrollment preference at registration.

Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before September 1 to register.

All new students must provide:

- an original birth certificate with the raised seal,
- an Illinois driver's license or state ID card with a District 161 address,
- mortgage or current lease with a District 161 address,
- Three of the following with a current date and a District 161 address: utility bill, property tax bill, auto insurance policy, voter's registration card, home or apartment insurance policy, or license plate registration.

Illinois State Law requires a physical exam with lead assessment, a dental exam and an eye exam for all children entering kindergarten.
