Lunchroom & Lunch Line

Be Respectful

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to oneself
- Use appropriate language and volume
- Keep food on the table
- Eat and touch only your own lunch
- Use "Please" and "Thank You" when speaking to adults and peers
- Stop talking when instructions from lunchroom supervisors need to be given

Be Responsible

- Have your own ID on and visible
- Leave all books and supplies in hall locker
- Keep single file in the lunch line
- Go to the back of the lunch line
- Bills should not be greater than \$10.00
- Walk in the lunchroom
- Only handle food items you intend to buy
- Use good table manners

Be Reliable

- Have your money ready
- Buy only your own lunch
- Go directly from cafeteria to lunchroom
- Sit only at your assigned lunch table
- Only 16 students per table
- Clean all food waste and garbage
- Wait to be dismissed from lunchroom
- Go directly from lunchroom to locker

Media Center

Be Respectful

- Obey school rules on no food, drinks, or gum
- Treat other students and media staff politely
- Use quiet voices

Be Responsible

- Have your ID to check out books
- Return library materials on time
- Have a pass from a teacher to use the media center or lab

Be Reliable

- Take care of library materials
- Use library equipment and computers appropriately
- Sign in if necessary

Assemblies

Be Respectful

- Sit quietly
- Eyes forward
- Listen
- Show appreciation

Be Responsible

- Walk with your class in a single file line to the bleachers
- Classes will be seated one row at a time, follow directions
- Wait to be dismissed by an adult
- Classes will be dismissed one row at a time, follow directions

Be Reliable

- Sit in your assigned area
- Keep appropriate space between peers
- Be a good participant

Parker Junior High School Expectations

Bus & Bus Stop

Be Respectful

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to oneself
- Speak pleasantly to the bus driver when spoken to and follow directions
- Speak with good purpose, using quiet voices and appropriate language

Be Responsible

- Always sit on the bus with feet on the floor and aisles clear
- Get on your assigned bus
- Be alert to traffic at your bus stop
- Line up single file
- Keep track of your belongings
- No food or drink on the bus

Be Reliable

- Be at your bus stop on time
- Go directly to your bus when you leave the building
- Put trash in trash bags
- Keep from speaking or interacting with people outside the bus
- Keep all items inside the bus

Entry & Exit

Be Respectful

- Speak to others pleasantly and use appropriate language
- Wait calmly to enter the building
- Follow adult direction
- Take hat off when you enter the building

Be Responsible

- Avoid conflicts and horseplay
- Enter immediately when whistle is blown
- Go directly to your locker or homeroom when you enter
- Walk your bike off campus

Be Reliable

- Enter and exit through appropriate door
- Go to the back of the line at your assigned door when you arrive
- Walkers leave campus as soon as you are out of the building

Hallway & Locker

Be Respectful

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to oneself
- Speak politely when addressed and follow directions
- Use appropriate language and volume
- Treat others in the hall as you want to be treated

Be Responsible

- Stay to the right side of hallway
- Have your ID on and visible
- Walk safely
- Keep a clean locker
- Use only your own locker and keep it locked

Be Reliable

- Go directly to your next class
- Be on time to class
- Only use locker at appropriate times
- Have a hall pass when in the hall or at locker during class time
- Do not use the gyms as hallways

Gymnasium

Be Respectful

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to oneself
- Be aware of others during participation
- Be attentive during class instruction
- Speak only at appropriate times
- Keep quiet during attendance
- Be a good sport

Be Responsible

- Take care of the P.E. equipment
- Follow the rules of the game
- Keep gym areas clean
- Walk to and from the gym when class begins and ends
- Remain quiet between the gym and locker room

Be Reliable

- Be on time for class
- Come prepared for class
- Be ready for dismissal to your next class
- Enter and exit the gym quietly
- P.E. equipment may not be used without permission
- Do not use the gyms as hallways
- Do not enter the MUR when a class is in session

Locker Room

Be Respectful

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to oneself
- Respect others' property
- Use appropriate tone and volume
- Follow adult directions
- Avoid conflict, gossip, and horseplay

Be Responsible

- Use only your own P.E. lock and locker everyday
- Bring your P.E. uniform everyday
- Keep your locker clean
- Wash your P.E. uniform weekly
- STAY AT YOUR OWN LOCKER
- No food, gum, or candy in the locker room

Be Reliable

- Be aware of the time allowed to dress before and after class
- Be on time and seated for attendance at designated class site
- Go to the gym directly after dressing

Classroom

Be Respectful

- Wait until someone finishes speaking before raising your hand
- Listen to what others have to say
- Speak when addressed
- Use appropriate language, tone, and volume
- Keep hands, feet, and objects to oneself
- Honor the property of others
- Avoid gossip about others

Be Responsible

- Follow teacher directions
- Focus on teacher instruction
- Turn in homework on time
- Return papers requiring parent signature on time
- Use assignment notebook
- Wear ID
- Maintain a clean working area
- No gum, food, or candy

Be Reliable

- Bring necessary materials
- Be truthful at all times
- Be in assigned seat and quiet when bell rings

- Have needed materials on desk when bell rings
- Avoid verbal or physical confrontations
- No cheating or plagiarism

Washroom

Be Respectful

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to oneself
- Respect others' space
- Be patient and wait your turn
- If the washroom is full you need to wait outside
- Enter and exit the washroom quietly

Be Responsible

- Wash your hands with soap and water
- Get permission to use the washroom/ have a pass
- Avoid verbal and physical confrontations
- Use washroom equipment responsibly

Be Reliable

- Only enter the washroom when using it
- Clean up after oneself/use the trash can
- Go directly from classroom to washroom
- Go directly to class after using the washroom

Office Areas

Be Respectful

- Keep hands and feet to yourself
- Speak in a positive, friendly, and quiet tone
- Sit quietly while waiting
- Accept directions from adults
- Respect the privacy of others

Be Responsible

- Check in with a secretary
- School phone used for school related business only
- Sign up for appointments with Deans, Counselors, etc.

Be Reliable

- Get a pass to go to the office
- Be on time to take medication
- Know what you need before you come to the office
- Ask for a pass before you go back to class
