Flossmoor School District 161 has scheduled an additional registration for incoming kindergarten students who will enter the schools this fall.

Kindergarten registration will be offered from 4 to 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 25, at Parker Junior High School, 2810 School Street, Flossmoor, IL.

A full day program (8:40 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.) is available at each elementary school. A District half-day program will be offered for students who want a half-day program at their home school. This program will be embedded into the full-day program. Students in this program will attend school from 8:40 a.m. – 11:50 a.m.

Parents indicate their enrollment preference at registration.

Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before September 1 to register.

Parent/Guardian must provide:

- **an original birth certificate with the raised seal,**
- **an Illinois driver's license or state ID card with a District 161 address,**
- **mortgage or current lease with a District 161 address,**
- **One of the following with a current date and a District 161 address: utility bill, (water, gas, or electric only) Homeowner's/ Renter's insurance policy**

Illinois State Law requires a physical exam with lead assessment, a dental exam, and an eye exam for all children entering kindergarten.
