**8th Graders:** Friday, May 16 is the 8th grade graduation dance/party. According to the school handbook you must be in attendance for at least 3.5 hours in order to attend any after school activity. If you are leaving early and arrive to school in time for homeroom, you are allowed to leave at 12:30 p.m. This is not an early dismissal day for all eighth graders and in order to leave early, you must turn in an early dismissal note during homeroom. If you will be leaving with another person's parent, your note must state that as well. If you are leaving early and turn in your note, you must come to the Media Center at the prearranged time and wait for your parent/guardian to sign you out at the front desk.

Also to attend the dance, you must bring your current Parker ID with your name and picture on it. You will also need this in order to attend the class trip on Monday, May 19. You will not have to wear your ID at the dance, you will turn it in when you enter the dance and will get it back in homeroom on Monday in time for the field trip.

There will be a professional photographer taking pictures the night of the dance. Each eighth grader is entitled to one free picture and you will be able to purchase additional pictures for \$7.00. You must pay for these pictures when they are taken.
